



## Low or No-cost **Breast** and **Cervical** Cancer Screening Services/ Follow-Up Care Available for Women

### *Wisconsin Well Woman Program is ready to help*

Whether insured or not, the Wisconsin Well Woman Program (**WWWP**) will help women receive the care they need.

The WWWP can arrange for program-eligible women to receive breast and cervical cancer screenings, follow-up care for an abnormal test result, and treatment – if breast or cervical cancer is diagnosed.

Eligible women must be between the ages of 21-64 (cervical) and 40-64 (breast) with an income ≤ 250 % of the Federal Poverty Level.

- Uninsured women can enroll in the program and receive cancer screening services (mammograms and Pap tests) at no cost.
- Underinsured women (women with high deductibles) may receive screening and/or diagnostic services not paid by their insurance.
