Who said there is no such thing as a FREE breakfast and lunch? Not us! We are again submitting our application to Amy Kalano at the DPI Office and we can offer both a breakfast and lunch to all area children as part of the USDA Summer Food program again this summer during our summer school programming. The School District of Florence County has agreed to offer the USDA Summer Food Program including breakfast and lunch.

At Florence Elementary School, located on William Anderson Drive a free breakfast will be offered Mondays and Wednesdays the weeks of June 17th, 24th and July 8th and 15th. In addition, the week of July 29th lunch will be served Monday-Thursday. On the week of July 1st the meal sites will be closed. These dates correspond to our summer programming, but you do not have to be signed up for the summer program to receive the free meals.

The NWTC Woodland Center in Aurora (2030 Calvary Dr. Niagara) will offer both breakfast and lunch on the following dates; June 18, 20, 25 & 27; July 9, 11, 16 and 18. This corresponds with the Food, Fun & Fitness (FFF) program, however you need not be signed up for the FFF program to come and enjoy a breakfast or lunch.

Breakfast time will be from 8:30-9:30 a.m. and lunch time is from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for both sites. I will send you a copy of the menu when they are ready.

In these tough economic times this is really exciting news for all families and would appreciate anything that you can do to help us get the word out. All children can come to either the Florence Elementary or Hillcrest building (dates stated above) to have a nutritious breakfast or lunch free of charge. Adults are welcome to join their children for a cost of \$4.00. We hope that you will mention and encourage any families with children to come and participate.

In order to assure that all children receive a healthy meal our entire FFF staff will be trained to assure we have complied with this awesome USDA Summer Food Program. We will also publish this program in our local newspapers and post it in many areas of the county.

Thank you for assisting us in getting the word out about this great program.
