Quarterly Update

DATCP

- FCHD is in the midst of another permit cycle of the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) Fiscal year 2023-2024. This program runs July 1-June 30 each year.
- There continues to be county-wide establishment updates, including an increase in short term rentals and retail food operators in the NWTC Woodland Kitchen!
- As of this quarter, the total number of Tourist Rooming Houses (Airbnb/VRBO) licensed in Florence County is 46.



<u>DNR</u>

- The 2023 Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Drinking Water and Groundwater Program inspection cycle is nearing the end for this year. The program manages activities that affect the safety, quality and availability of drinking water to protect public health and water resources. These include restaurants, campgrounds, town houses and churches not on the public water system. The DNR Drinking Water and Groundwater Program runs calendar year (Jan-Dec).
- WISCONSIN DEFT. OF NATURAL RESOURCES
- During annual DNR inspections, FCHD staff collect drinking water. Samples are tested for bacteria and nitrate.

How well do you know your drinking water system?

Options to protect your water system

Well casing- the requirements for wells are found in ss. NR 812 but generally, the casing should be 12" above the ground level and not rusted or showing signs of corrosion. The well should be adequately protected from environmental and physical damage (plow trucks).

Well cap- the cap should be vermin proof and tightly installed with screws to prevent entrance of insects, rodents and/or bugs.
